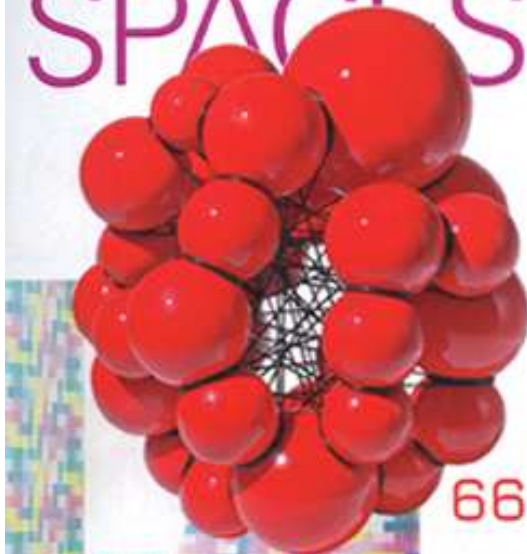

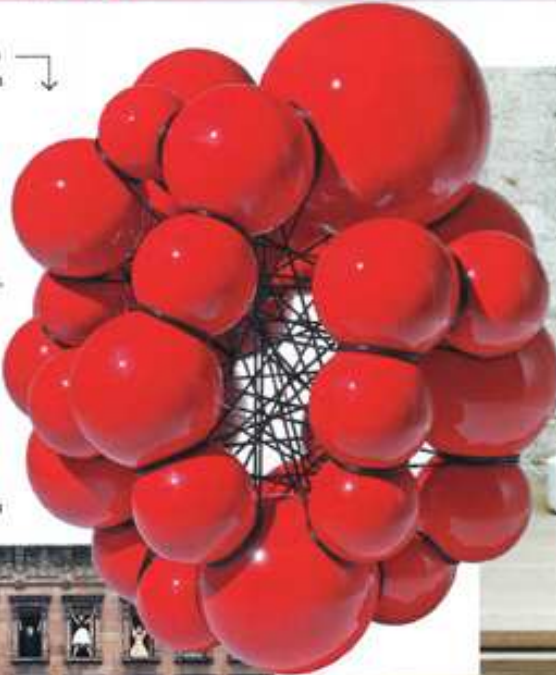


ROLE MODEL

CHAIR MAN

“A chair should have no rear side. It should be beautiful from all sides and angles,” asserted Danish furniture master Hans Wegner (1914-2007)—and he ought to know. In his lifetime, Wegner designed more than 500 chairs, including the streamlined CH 33, introduced in 1957, and brought back into production by Carl Hansen & Son this year. carlhansen.com
